## **CMEEC COVID Guidelines**



## Meals

- Eat outside if possible, spaced 6' apart
  - Eating at picnic table corners is 6', eating with three people at a table (2 corners and the middle) is 4'
- If indoors...
  - o prop open both main sets of lodge doors using stoppers (black wedges)
  - Gently close retractable screens to prevent rodent/bat entry
  - Try to minimize in/out of lodge when screens are closed (they're not that strong)
  - o Turn on fans to high...control is to the left of main lodge doors
  - Space tables so that students can eat 6' apart
  - Leave kitchen roll-up closed to protect kitchen crew

# Library

- Sanitize before and after handling library items
- Hand sanitizer is mounted at the library entryway
- Remember to keep all library items in the main lodge

#### **Showers and Restrooms**

- Keep an empty stall in between bathers when showers are in use (one person every other stall)
- After showering, prop open both front and back restroom doors with wedges
- Place orange cone in each door to indicate restrooms are closed
- Use the "closed until" sign to indicate time when showers can be re-opened
- Ventilate showers for 2 hours following use
- Toothbrushing maximize space between campers when brushing as masks will be removed
- Masks should be worn in restrooms at all times unless showering or tootbrushing
- Spray high touch surfaces with sanitizer at least once per day during your stay

## **Sleeping in Cabins**

- Avoid doubling up in bunks when possible (one person only per bunk)
  - If doubling up is necessary, sleep in a head-to-toe configuration
- Bunks are spaced so that campers will be about 5' apart when lying on their mattresses, head-to-toe sleeping is recommended
- DO NOT prop open cabin doors
- Open windows for maximum ventilation
- Campers should be responsible for their own belongings and not touch other people's stuff
- Hand sanitizer is provided in each cabin

**If COVID suspected** – quarantine in the first aid room of the Annex, close ceiling vent, and open all windows until camper can be transported offsite for evaluation and care.
