

Point Reyes National Seashore Association (PRNSA) Art Exhibit Agreement

This agreement outlines the terms and conditions for artists exhibiting and selling artwork at the Bear Valley Visitor Center, administered by the Point Reyes National Seashore Association (PRNSA) and in partnership with the National Park Service (NPS).

1. Application Process

Artists must apply through PRNSA Art Exhibit Application Form.

Applications will be reviewed by a committee consisting of PRNSA and NPS staff members. Applications are accepted year-round and are reviewed in September for the following calendar year.

2. Exhibit Guidelines

All exhibits must feature artwork available for sale; exhibitions without sales will not be considered.

Exhibits are installed for two-month increments as follows:

- January/February
- March/April
- May/June
- - July/August
- September/October
- (Note: The Coastal Commission hosts a children's exhibit in November/December.)

Art is to be installed on the 1st of the starting month and removed on the last day of the ending month.

Art displays must remain within the auditorium hallway walls. A small standing rack may be used at the entrance of the hallway.

3. Installation Requirements

The artist is responsible for all tools and equipment necessary to hang their art, including ladders, step stools, hammers, nails, etc. An NPS Interpretive Ranger will oversee the art installation.

PRNSA is not responsible for any damage to artwork or equipment during installation or the exhibition period, including damage caused by the general public, staff, or changing environmental conditions at the Bear Valley Visitor Center.

4. Sales Terms

Artwork is sold on consignment:

- - 70% of the sale price goes to the artist
- - 30% goes to PRNSA

Artists must submit a complete inventory spreadsheet including titles, descriptions, and prices two weeks prior to the exhibit start date.

Artists authorize PRNSA to sell their work and understand that all sales are processed exclusively through PRNSA.

5. Liability Waiver

The artist agrees to hold PRNSA harmless for any damages, loss, or theft of artworks while on display or in storage at the Bear Valley Visitor Center.
