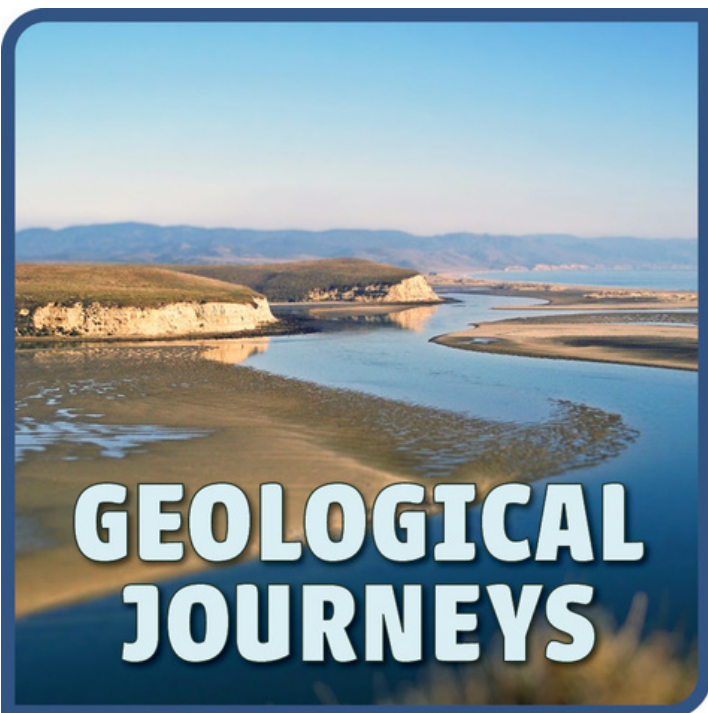
Underground Clues: Unearthing "Plant Stones" in Coastal Grasslands

Distance: ~3 miles Difficulty: Moderate

Stories in Stone: The History of Point Reyes Through Geology



Explore the history of Point Reyes through geology. What can rocks, soil, and fossils reveal about the past, and predict about the future?

Distance: ~5 miles Difficulty: Challenging

Reading the Landscape: Wildlife Tracking and Mountain Beaver Research



Explore the basics of wildlife tracking and learn about research on the behaviors and movements of the elusive Point Reyes mountain beaver.

Distance: ~1 mile Difficulty: Moderate

Restoring the Dunes: Habitat Resilience at Abbotts Lagoon



Explore the vibrant coastal dune habitat at Abbotts Lagoon and learn how restoration efforts are protecting native plants and wildlife.

Distance: ~4 miles Difficulty: Moderate

Monitoring the Marsh: Tracking Plant Communities in the Giacomini Wetlands



Learn about the historic Giacomini Wetland restoration project and biologists' work to monitor the site's flourishing plant communities.

Distance: ~2 miles Difficulty: Easy

Burn Zone Birds: Forest and Avian Resilience in Bear Valley



Absorb the vibrancy of Bear Valley Trail while learning about this forest's resilience through the lens of birds and post-fire regeneration.

Distance: ~4 miles Difficulty: Moderate

Coast Miwok History & Co-Stewardship in Point Reyes



Learn about the Coast Miwok and Southern Pomo peoples' special connection to Point Reyes on this talk and guided plant walk.

Distance: <1 mile Difficulty: Easy
